



STUDENT ACCESS CONTRACT

I hereby release Willows Preparatory School (WPS), its personnel, and any other institutions with which it is affiliated, from any and all claims and damages of any nature arising from my child's use of, or inability to use, the Internet Access, including all, but not limited to claims that may arise from the unauthorized use of the system to purchase products or services.

I will instruct my child regarding any restrictions against accessing materials as outlined by the **Internet Acceptable Use Policy** for Willows Preparatory School. I will emphasize to my child the importance of following rules for personal safety.

If my child is below the age of 13, I give Willows Preparatory School permission to register a Microsoft account and other online accounts for my child with the understanding that the account will only be used for educational purposes and will only be allowed to communicate within the Willows Preparatory School e-mail network. (In compliance with the Child Online Privacy Protection Act (COPPA) of 1998, Willows Preparatory School will not collect information about any student under the age of 13 without parental consent.)

As the parent or guardian of this student, I have read the Acceptable Use Policy for Willows Preparatory School. I hereby give my permission for my child to use the Internet and will not hold Willows Preparatory School liable as a result of the use of the Internet on school premises by my child. I understand that my child has agreed not to access inappropriate material on the Internet.

INTERNET ACCEPTABLE USE POLICY

Willows Preparatory School (WPS) makes Internet access available to students while on campus. Students are expected to use the WPS provided Internet responsibly and for school-related purposes only. As a condition for accessing the Internet, students understand and agree with the following:

- Use of the Internet is a privilege. If any of the “conditions of use” are violated, then the privilege may be taken away by WPS teachers or administrators, and other consequences may follow.
- Use of the Internet is for school-related purposes only. School administrators will decide what constitutes a violation of Internet policies. Violations include, but are not limited to:
 - Transmission, creation of, or deliberate access to obscene, indecent, harassing, defamatory, or otherwise offensive material in any form.
 - Access to any personal information page. (ex: Facebook or Twitter)
 - Any deliberate attempt to harm or destroy data.
 - Unauthorized installation, storage, or distribution of copyrighted software or files.
 - Violation of policies or federal and state laws. School administrators have the right to review any material received, sent, viewed, or stored on computers, including websites and emails. School administrators can edit or remove any material believed to be unlawful, obscene, indecent, harassing, or otherwise objectionable.
- Students are prohibited from giving out personal information such as their name, picture, telephone number, or home address while using the internet at school.
- Willows Preparatory School does not guarantee that the function of the Internet service will meet any specific requirements students may have or that the Internet service will be error-free or uninterrupted.
- All other related student policies are applicable.
