At Willow's Preparatory School, our Student Support Program helps students build the skills, strategies, and confidence they need to access their learning environment. We offer flexible support tailored to each learner, including one-on-one sessions and small group options available both during and after the school day. Each offer focuses on strengthening essential skills. Through close collaboration with families, teachers, and support specialists, we create a strong network of advocacy for each student.

Elective Course Options: The Student Support Program offers two elective courses designed to help students build independence, organization, and academic confidence. Students may enroll in one of these courses in place of a regular elective for a single semester or the full year. With a 1:4 teacher-to-student ratio, each class provides highly individualized support. The instructor serves both as a teacher and advocate, acting as a central point of communication among students, teachers, and families to coordinate accommodations and monitor academic progress. Through consistent routines, including planning sessions and weekly student-written progress emails, students develop essential skills in time management, self-advocacy, and academic responsibility. These structured practices empower students to take ownership of their learning.

2025–2026 Tuition: \$4,650 per semester

- **Option 1: Strategies for Success**

- This semester or yearlong class teaches students key executive functioning skills through direct instruction of a structured curriculum, while fostering greater awareness of their individual learning styles. Students develop and practice organization, planning, time and task management, prioritization, and task initiation, and learn how to create habits and routines that support academic success and self-advocacy.

- **Option 2: Guided Learning Lab**

- This semester or yearlong class provides students with a quiet, structured environment to manage and make progress toward their academic workload, and practice executive functioning skills. In small cohorts, learners work closely with a dedicated teacher who helps them track assignments, break down complex tasks, and prioritize their to-do lists while completing their course work. Students will also receive skill and content-based support related to their course content.

Weekly 1:1 Check-ins: Students participate in 20–30 minutes of personalized one-on-one weekly executive functioning and academic coaching support during the school day. Check-ins focus on reviewing grades, tracking assignments, breaking down and prioritizing tasks, addressing challenges, and celebrating progress. These sessions also help students develop effective communication and self-advocacy skills. Meeting time is coordinated directly with families and students. Students may enroll for one or two semesters per year. **2025–2026 tuition:** \$2,500.00 per semester.

After School Learning Support: Our structured after-school program is designed to build essential organizational skills and academic confidence. Available Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays, students can enroll for one, two, or all three days based on their needs. In this supportive environment, students learn to stay on top of their responsibilities using planners, digital calendars, and task lists to track assignments and prioritize their work. Guided support is available for homework and study skills, helping students develop independence and time management. **2025–2026 tuition:** \$600 per semester, per day. Mon & Tue: 3:30–4:30 p.m., Wed: 2:30–3:30 p.m.

Social Lunch Circle: Through guided activities and discussions, students learn strategies for starting conversations, active listening, perspective-taking, managing emotions, resolving conflicts, navigating peer pressure, and building healthy relationships. This program helps students develop the confidence and skills they need to connect meaningfully with their peers in both academic and in social settings. Students enroll for 8–10-week sessions offered weekly during lunch and recess, providing a supportive space to practice essential social and interpersonal skills. **2025–2026 tuition:** \$500 per Fall, Winter, Spring session.

Speech and Language Therapy Services: Students with language-based disabilities such as Dyslexia, Dysgraphia, Auditory Processing, etc. can experience 1:1 direct, on-site remediation and support in areas of oral and written language with a licensed speech-language pathologist during the school day. **2025–2026 SLP Tuition:** \$140/50 -minute session; however, these services may be eligible for insurance reimbursement.
